

Latest SATS Results

We are proud of our Year 6 results because they represent a small part of the work we do to ensure all children leave Broom Barns ready for secondary school and beyond.

Broom Barns enjoys being a highly inclusive school and we support a significant number of children with special educational needs. Where these needs are related to cognitive function, this can have an impact on our 'headline' results. This must be taken into account when parents & carers are trying to understand the success of the school.

In 2015, 32% of the Year 6 cohort had this type of special education need. This means our Year 6 results show that, overall, children achieve good or better standards as they travel through our school.

Progress

In 2015, we achieved:

- Two levels progress in Reading: **95%**
- Two levels progress in Writing: **95%**
- Two levels progress in Maths: **89%**

Attainment

The government target for attainment is 85% children reaching Level 4 by end of KS2.

In 2015, we achieved:

- Level 4+ Reading: **89%** (Test)
- Level 5+ Reading: **42%** (Test)

- Level 4+ Writing: **74%** (Teacher Assessment)
- Level 5 Writing: **37%** (Teacher Assessment)

- Level 4+ Maths: **79%** (Test)
- Level 5+ Maths: **47%** (Test)

The government target for combined Level 4+ in Reading, Writing & Maths is 65%. In 2015, we achieved **74%**.
