## Light It Up workshop – 17th November 2017

On Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> November 2017, we have organised an exciting, practical workshop for our pupils in year 5 and 6 to take part in. This will take place in school. This will be run by SETPOINT, who have over 30 years' experience in delivering high quality STEM (Science, Technology and Maths) workshops to school. These provide an insight and greater awareness of how these subjects can lead to a fascinating and worthwhile career.

**We have already heavily subsidised the cost of this experience but do ask parents to support this by contributing £4.00 per child.**

In each session, the children will use a range of tools and equipment necessary for circuit building and eventually their learning will culminate in them producing an electrical quiz game.

The work shop has links with the curriculum in the following areas:

**D & T** Developing, planning and communicating ideas - Working with tools, equipment, materials and components to make quality products - Evaluating processes and products

**Science** Sc1 working scientifically - Sc3 everyday materials and their properties – Sc4 Electricity – Circuits

**English:** Speaking and listening

Each workshop lasts, approximately, 2 ½ hours, so we have organised for year 5 to participate in the morning and year 6 in the afternoon. Year 6 parents, please note that your child's workshop will not finish until 3.30pm on that day.
