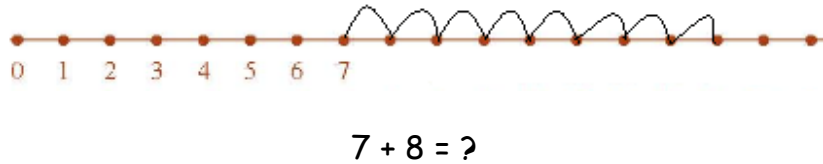
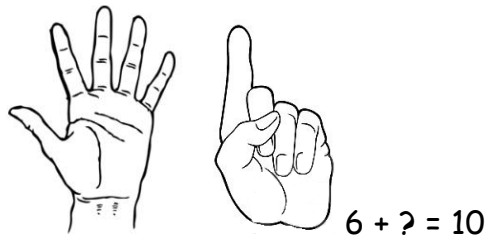
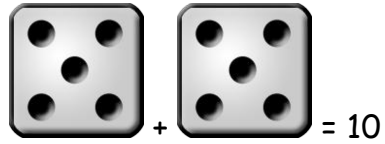

## Addition

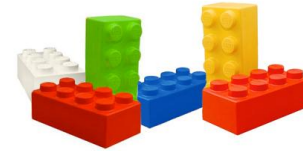
$$1 + 2 = 3$$

What does this look like?

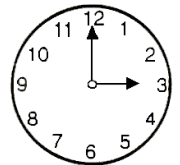


How can I help?
