Y3 to Y6 Curling – Wednesdays – 3rd Jun to 15th Jul (6 sessions) £14



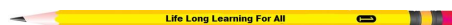

BIKE SHELTERS AND SCOOTER PODS

We have two bike shelters on the school grounds and kindly ask that all bikes are stored in these shelters only, rather than in the scooter pods. There is also a “walk your wheels” rule on site—please help us keep everyone safe by reminding your child about this.

We encourage the use of bike locks. While bikes are generally safe during the school day, once the gates open at the end of the day the grounds become accessible to the public and, unfortunately, bikes have been stolen in the past. Please note that all bikes and scooters are left at the owner’s own risk.



Parent Partnership Request

We kindly ask for your support with keeping all children and families safe at drop-off and pick-up times. To help reduce the risk of accidents, we would be very grateful if parents/carers could **avoid dropping children or other adults off at the top of the drive and then reversing back up or turning around in this area.** The drive can become busy at peak times, and reversing manoeuvres present a safety concern for pedestrians, particularly children.
