We can play outdoors as well.



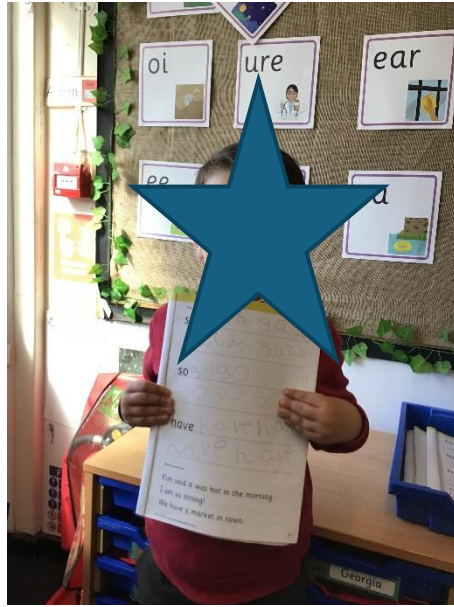
This is where you can go to the toilet

We have lots of topics to learn about together.



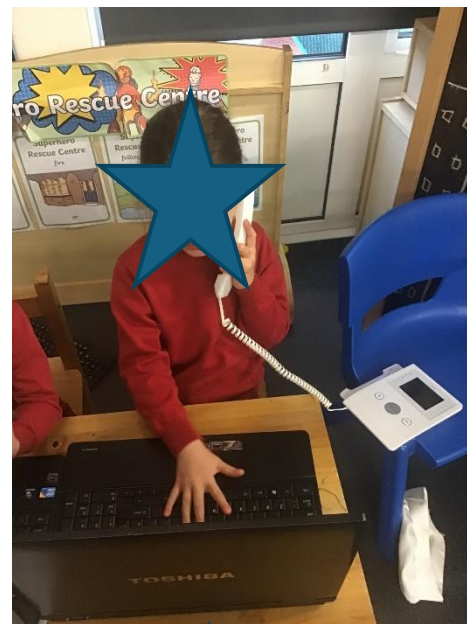
In math's lessons, we will learn all about numbers and shapes. We will learn new ways to solve problems and use lots of practical resources to do so!

Top Tips for parents and carers:

- Book bags should be clearly labelled and in school every day along with your child's reading record and reading book. Backpacks are not needed, and we do not have the space for them.
- Children will have their reading books changed weekly. Please encourage your child to read a part of their reading book each day. Children visit our school library and choose a new book every Thursday.
- Every Monday and Wednesday we have our PE lessons. Children will be supported with changing into and out of their PE kits. Please keep PE kits in school and we will send them each half-term. No earrings are allowed for PE lessons, so please remove earrings before coming to school.
- Earrings can be worn on non-PE days, they must be studs.
- Please make sure all uniform, hats, water bottles, etc. are clearly labelled.
- Children can bring in a show and tell toy on a Friday; it needs to fit in their book bag.
- You will be able to keep up to date with Reception and school events by checking and reading Arbor messages. A curriculum letter about the new learning your child will be completing will be sent half termly.
