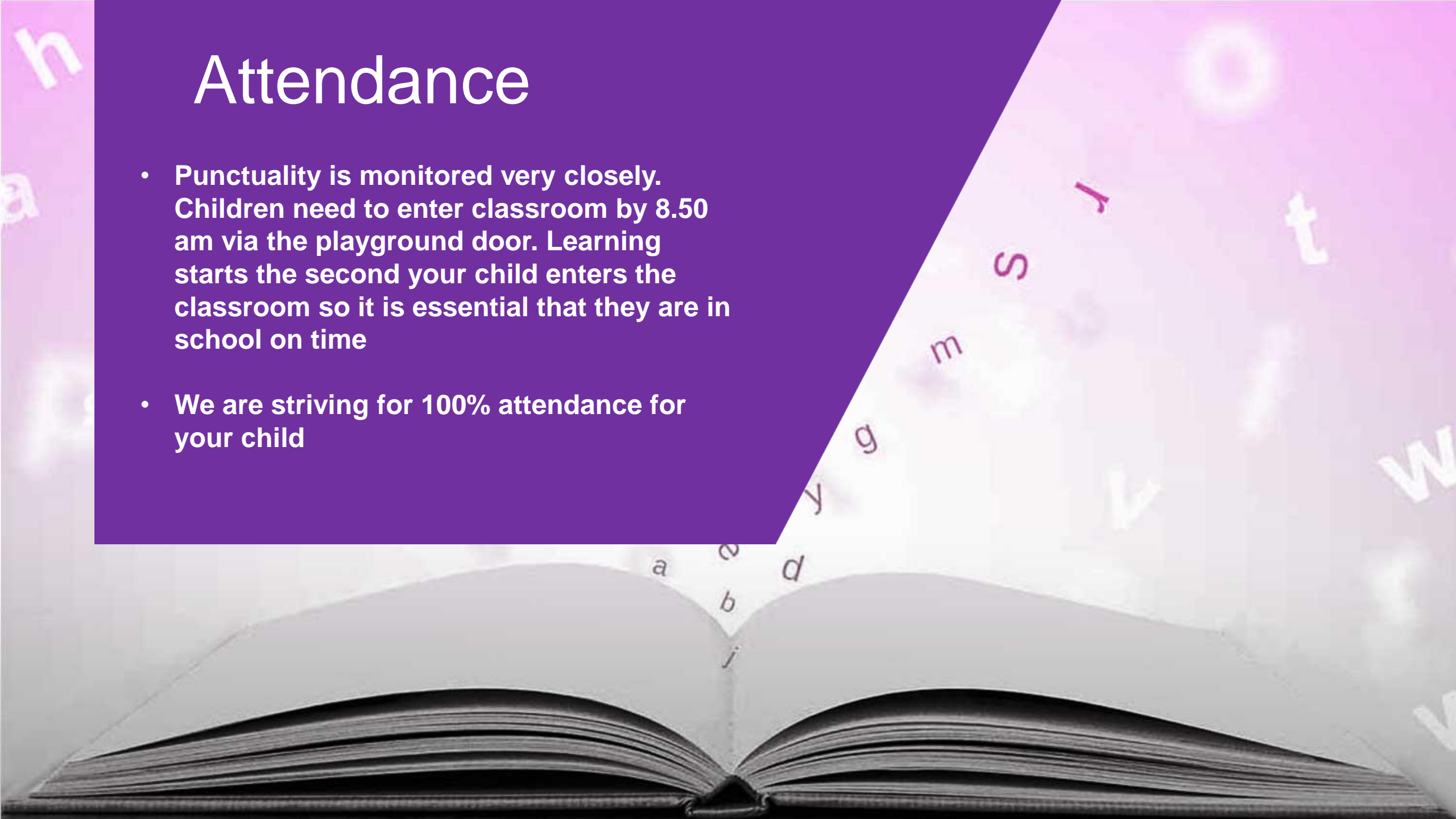

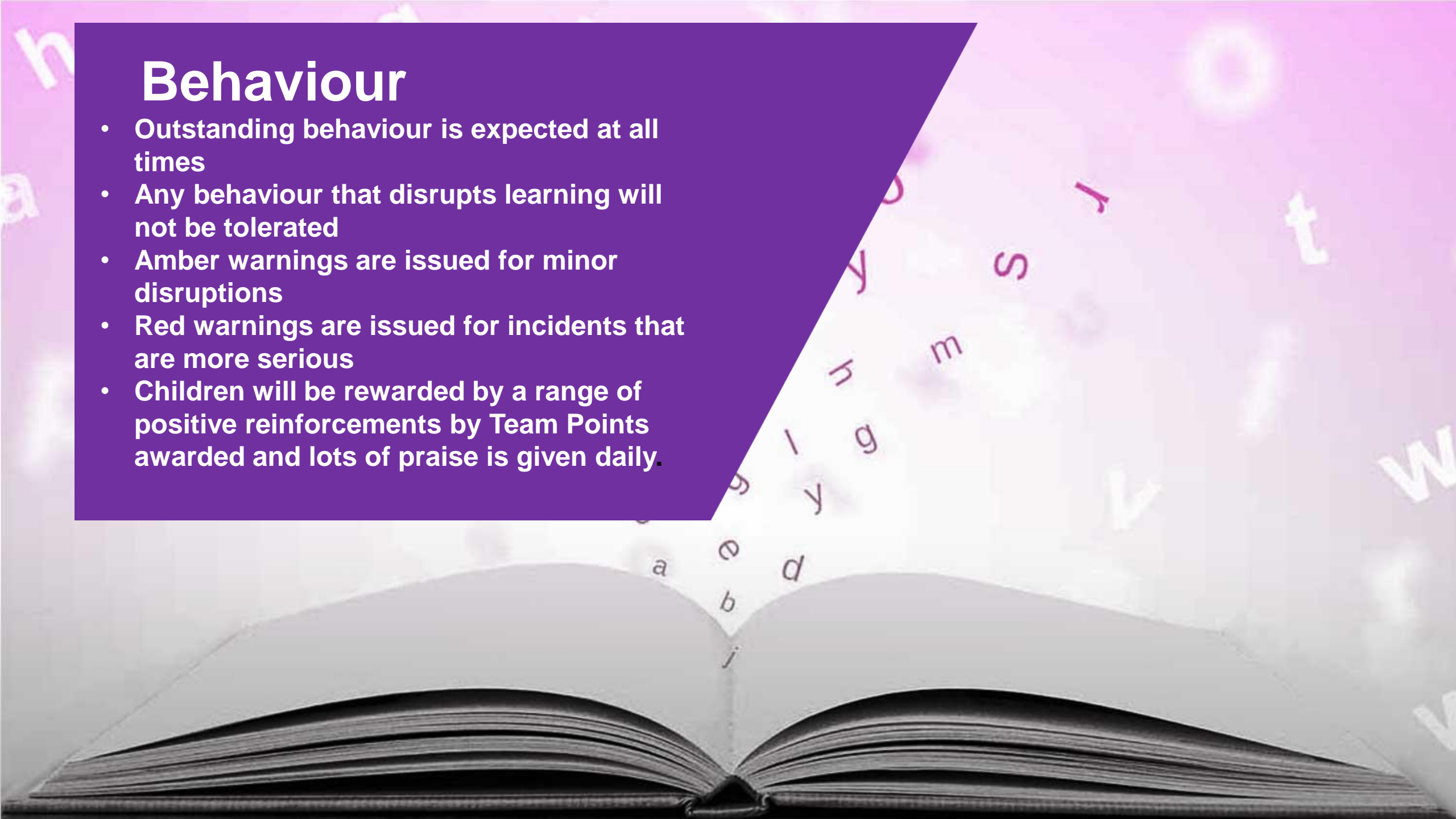
Year 5 have lots to look forward to in terms of learning this year.

- Children will be rewarded by a range of positive reinforcements by Team Points awarded and lots of praise is given daily.

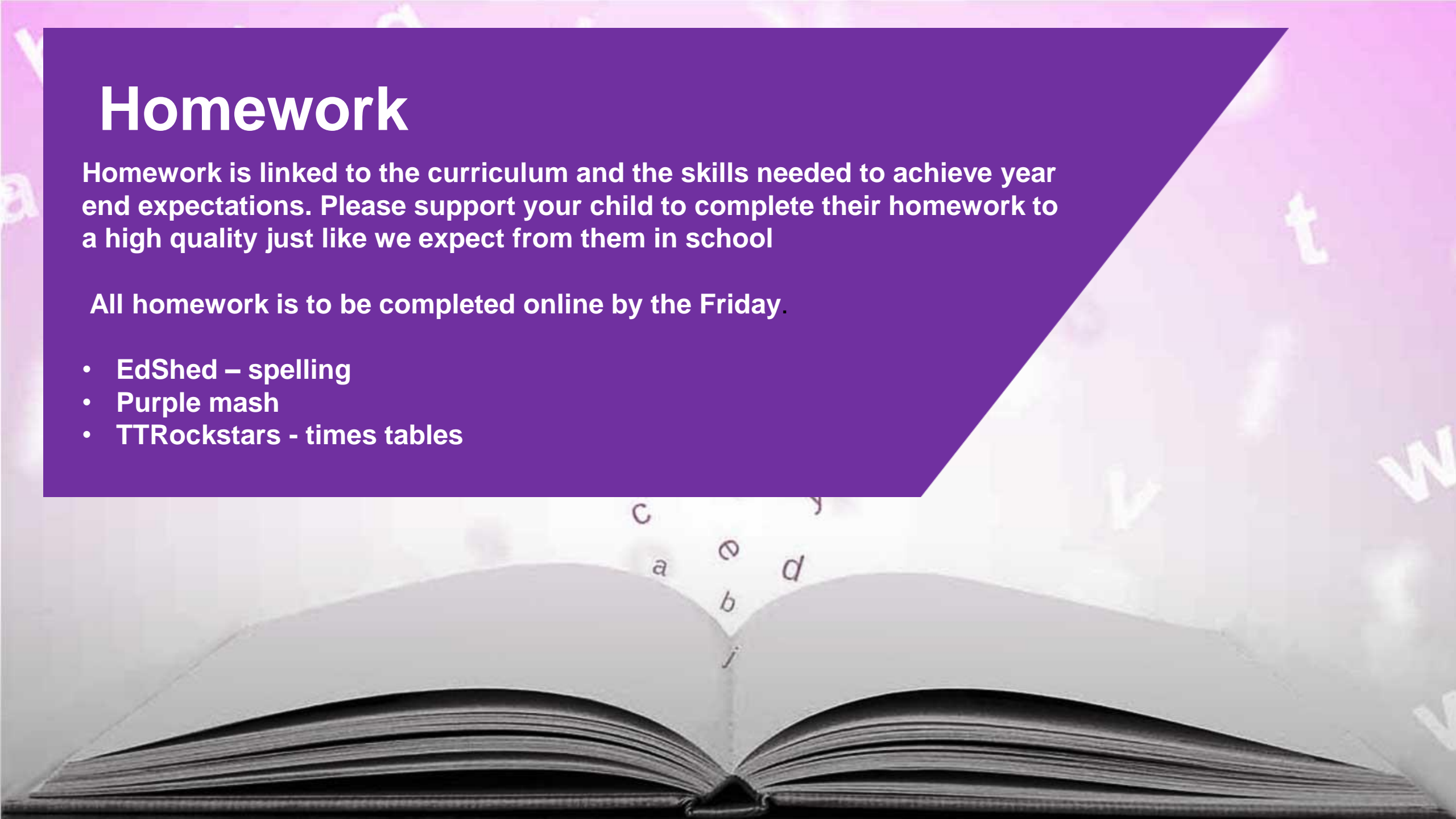


Homework

Homework is linked to the curriculum and the skills needed to achieve year end expectations. Please support your child to complete their homework to a high quality just like we expect from them in school

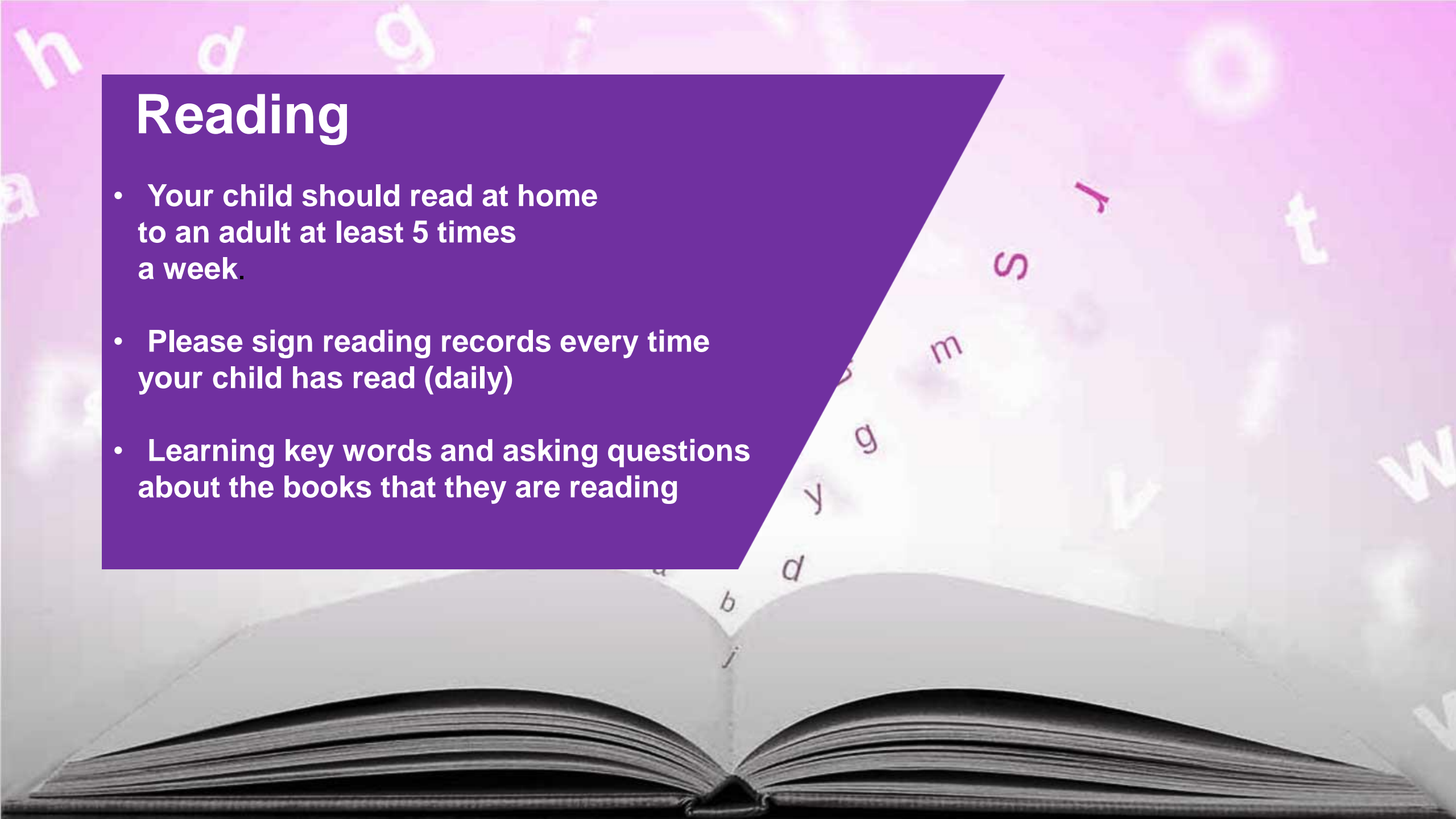
All homework is to be completed online by the Friday.
