


Our behaviour policy:




Following instructions really well independently, showing good listening throughout lessons, being a kind member of the class and making great choices all day!







The Curriculum



English

A large emphasis on writing full sentences and the structure of them! We will be practicing saying sentences out loud first, to make sure they make sense. Then, pupils will use their phonics knowledge to help them write their full sentence.

Phonics

Essential Letters and Sounds (ELS) is our chosen phonics programme. Children will experience the joy of books and language whilst rapidly acquiring the skills they need to become fluent independent readers and writers.

Maths

The main focus currently will be place value of numbers 0 – 10. We will be sorting numbers of objects, counting forwards and backwards, ordering numbers and comparing numbers in terms of numbers being greater or less than another number.


