Tasks you must do:

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Read your reading book, or any other book, magazine etc. Read to someone in your family. AFTER reading, write 2 quiz questions about the book. See if your family member can answer them. Use Bug Club.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Write sentences with your spelling words from the list I gave you. Create your own Look, Cover, Write, Check Make up your own spelling games.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Times tables</u></p> <p>Practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Use times table Rock stars, Hit the Button, chant them, write them down or get a family member to test you!</p>
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Tasks you can choose do:

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Help around the house</u></p> <p>Make your bed Mow the lawn Do some dusting Clean the bathroom</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Create your own 2 times table number sentences! Roll a dice or 2! Each time you get a number multiply it by 2. Can you work out the answer or write it as a multiplication? If you don't have dice, you can make your own number cards 1-12 on small pieces of paper or ask a grown up to shout out a number for you to multiply by. Example: I roll a 6. So my multiplication would be $6 \times 2 = 12$. Challenge! Can you multiply by 3?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Instructions</u></p> <p>Look up words in a dictionary to find their meaning. Once you know the meaning, put the word into your own sentence.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Word find</u></p> <p>How many different words can you make from your surname?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Measuring</u></p> <p>Measure the length of five items. Use paper clips, coins, pens or something similar to measure the items. Line up the paper clips along the length of the item, then count the number of paper clips to see how long it is. Tell an adult what the longest item was and the shortest item was.</p>			<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sort it</u></p> <p>Ask an adult for a selection of objects such as hair clips, socks or toys. Then sort the items by size. Once you have finished, try sorting the items a different way, e.g. by colour, pattern, shape, etc.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Design a football kit</u></p> <p>Create a picture for each of the seasons: Winter, Spring, Summer and Autumn. Draw some of the activities that take place in each of the seasons. Use the colours you would see during each season.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical activity</u></p> <p>On your daily walk, find some nice size stones with a flat surface, paint them and make them into a paper weight.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Make a wordsearch</u></p> <p>Make a list of animals or your favourite toys and make a word search from them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Created a wanted poster</u></p> <p>A robber has robbed the sweet shop of all the sweets. Make a wanted poster for the police to find him. It has to say what he looks like, what he was wearing and you could also draw a picture of him.</p>
