<p><u>Reading</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Read a book to an adult. Read to someone in your family. Once you have read, at least a chapter, ask them 2 questions about the story.2) Use Bug Club.	<p><u>Spelling</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Create your own Look, Cover, Write, Check for a set of words from the year 2 spelling list2) Write sentences using these words3) Test an adult. Then check to see if they have got them correct without referring to your spelling list. Then check using your spelling list.	<p><u>Times tables</u></p> <p>Continue to practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Use times table Rock stars, Hit the Button, chant them, write them down or get a family member to test you!</p> <p>Once you are confident with these try your 3s.</p>	
<p><u>Make a model</u></p> <p>Make a scarecrow for a farmer who is having problems with birds eating his crops, using a range of different materials. Think about the ways you can keep the birds off of the crops.</p>	<p><u>Bake biscuits</u></p> <p>Make some biscuits. Read the recipe, weigh out the ingredients using scales and make. (with an adult) This does not need to be baked biscuits - you can make ones that go in the fridge.</p>	<p><u>Create a shop</u></p> <p>Choose items to put in your shop. Give them all a price. Make some paper money and give some of the money to your family. They can then come and buy things from your shop. Don't forget to use your adding skills and make sure you give them the correct change!</p>	<p><u>Number of days in a month</u></p> <p>Write all the months of the year in order. Record how many days are in each month. Then write a poem to help you remember.</p>
<p><u>Shape Hunt</u></p> <p>Go on a circle shape hunt around the house and list the items.</p>			<p><u>Numbers</u></p> <p>Practise ordering and writing numbers for 1 - 100. Write them in numbers and words. Continue, if you can, into the next hundred.</p>
