Tasks you must do:

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Read your reading book, or any other book, magazine etc. Read to someone in your family. AFTER reading, write 2 quiz questions about the book. See if your family member can answer them. Use Bug Club.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Write sentences with your spelling words from the list I gave you. Create your own Look, Cover, Write, Check Make up your own spelling games.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Times tables</u></p> <p>Practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Use times table Rock stars, Hit the Button, chant them, write them down or get a family member to test you!</p>
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Tasks you can choose do:

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Meal time</u></p> <p>Make sandwiches for lunch for your family.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Measuring</u></p> <p>Measure the length and height of items around your home or in the garden.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Treasure Hunt</u></p> <p>Hide an item somewhere inside or out and write clues for someone to find the treasure. Maybe they need to crawl across the couch, slide like a snail under a bed, reach behind a stool, or, if they're outside, run to the tree, jump off a tree stump, dig into a hole, etc. Get someone to follow your clues to find the treasure.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Using Adjectives</u></p> <p>Write a list of different adjectives and then write sentences with them in.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Learn that song</u></p> <p>Listen to your favourite song. Can you learn the lyrics? (the words to the song)</p>			<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Roll to win</u></p> <p>Roll two dice and add up the numbers that are rolled. Write down the total on a piece of paper. Reroll and keep adding up the numbers until you reach 100</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Make your own</u></p> <p>Make playdough out of water, oil, flour and salt. (There are lots of different recipes on line) How many different shapes can you make from your playdough?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical activity</u></p> <p>Choose a move and see how long you can perform it. How long can you balance on one foot? How long will it take to run up a hill? How long can they keep up a balloon? Get someone to time you.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Balance Building</u></p> <p>Choose different uneven objects such as cards, paper cups, or rocks and build as high as you can without it all falling over.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Write a letter</u></p> <p>Write a letter to a key worker thanking them for helping people.</p>
